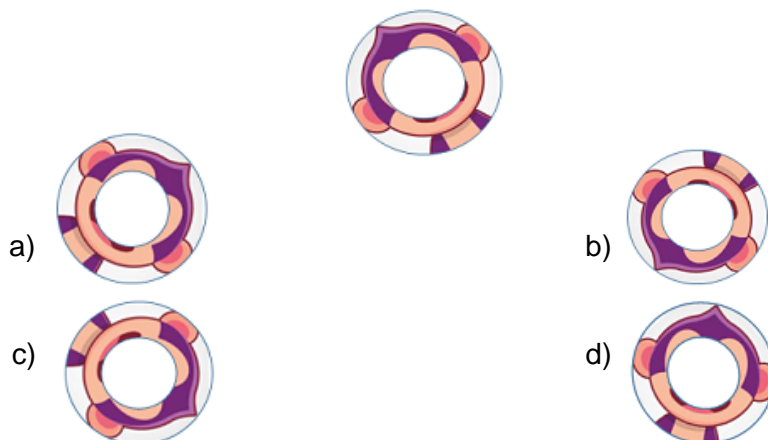
7. Parmila is going towards East. She turns left, moves on some distance and again turns to her left. After walking some distance she turns to her right and moves on. In which direction she is going now?
